**DRAFT NOTIFICATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Governor of the State of Jammu and Kashmir. has, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sub-clause (b) of clause (2) of Section 53 of the Constitution of Jammu and Kashmir, been pleased to dissolve the Legislative Assembly of the State on 10th July 2008 ; and

Whereas, in terms of sub-section (1) of section 27 of the Jammu and Kashmir Representation of the People Act, 1957 (IV of 1957), a general election has to be held for the purpose of constituting a new Legislative Assembly of the State;

Now, therefore, as recommended by the Election Commission of India in pursuance of sub-section (2) of section 27 of the said Act, the Governor of the State of Jammu and Kashmir is hereby pleased to call upon the following Assembly constituencies in the State, to elect members to the Legislative Assembly of the State, in accordance with the provisions of the said Act and of the rules and orders made thereunder:
